PEDESTRIANS

Wear light colour and reflective/high visibility jackets on a dull/foggy day or in the evening/at night.

Always choose a well-lit place when you cross the road.

Remember it takes drivers longer to stop a vehicle in wet or slippery conditions.

CYCLISTS

Wear light colours and reflective/high visibility jackets on a dull/foggy day or in the evening/at night.

Check tyres, lights and reflectors on your bike before you set off.

ALWAYS wear an approved cycle helmet.

SEASONAL ROAD SAFETY ADVICE

MOTORIST

Make sure all the lights on your vehicles are working.

Make sure your tyres have sufficient tread, and are inflated to the correct pressure recommended by the manufacturer.

Check that your windscreen washer bottle is full and that wipers are in good working order.

Make sure your engine cooling system is topped up with anti-freeze.

Ensure vehicle windows are clear of ice and mist before starting a journey.

Carry de-icer spray in your vehicle.

Leave an appropriate gap between you and the vehicle in front, especially during wet or icy conditions.

Allow extra time for any journey in adverse weather conditions and only undertake journeys when absolutely necessary.

ALWAYS wear a seatbelt.

NEVER drink and drive.

NEVER use a mobile phone/hand held device whilst driving.
