

# Severn Tunnel Junction Rail Link

## Information

From 21st November 2011, Grass Routes Community Transport Bus will begin the operation of the early morning and evening rail link journeys at Severn Tunnel Junction in Magor.

## What is Grass Routes?

The Grass Routes transport scheme is a demand responsive flexible bus service, operated by low floor, fully accessible vehicles. The scheme is operated on a membership basis and is open to all members of the community.

## How do I use it?

You must first become a member of Grass Routes. To obtain an application form call **0800 085 8015** or download a form from [www.monmouthshire.gov.uk/publictransport](http://www.monmouthshire.gov.uk/publictransport).

The cost of membership is a one off payment of £5.00 per household (up to four members).

Once you are a member, to book a journey on the bus, members need to call the free phone number manned from 09:00-16:30 (Mon-Fri). Telephone **0800 085 8015** at least 24hrs in advance to book their journey with the Grass Routes Co-ordinator.

## How much?

Each journey booked costs £2.75 per adult and £1.35 per child. This will cover both a single or return journey booked for that day. Concessionary passes are also accepted on all daily Grass Routes services.

## How do I pay?

Payment for journeys will be made through monthly invoicing.

## Meeting the train

The Grass Routes Rail Link will operate the following times Monday to Friday:

### Morning Operation

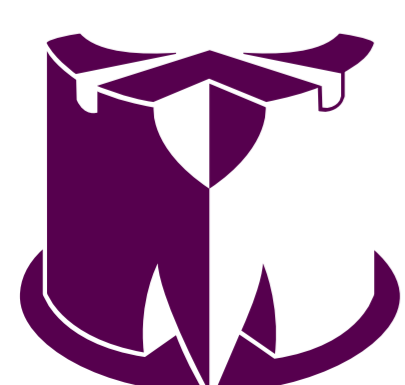
06:30 - 08:30am

### Evening Operation

16:30 - 18:00pm

Your booking can be made to pick up/drop off at your door or your nearest bus stop at a pick up time of your choice. Pick up times are flexible depending upon demand and regular journeys can be booked.

If your train should be cancelled or delayed, providing an initial booking has been made, contact the co-ordinator (within office hours) and we will arrange for a new pick up time.
