PRECEPT 2012/2013

The Community Council is funded by Council Tax. Each January the Community Council identifies local priorities and commitments for the forthcoming year and sets its' Budget and Precept. The Precept is then collected by the County Council on behalf of the Community Council. For the financial year, 2012/2013, the Community Council Precept is £98,445 (a reduction of over 10.00% from £111,918 in 2011/2012).

SO WHERE DOES THE MONEY GO?

For each £1 spent.....

- 0.01p - (0.56%) will pay for Community Publications, including Web Site, Newsletters
- 0.01p - (0.56%) will pay for Hall Hire, Leases on Allotments & Play Areas
- 0.02p - (1.73%) will pay for new Litter, Grit and Dog Waste Bins
- 0.02p - (2.10%) will contribute to Civic Events/projects (includes Queens Diamond Jubilee)
- 0.03p - (3.35%) will be spent on Summer Play Schemes for local children
- 0.04p - (4.27%) will pay for Community Grants to SARA, CAB, Air Ambulance, Local Projects & Organisations
- 0.05p - (5.16%) will be spent on Summer Floral Displays and Xmas Lighting
- 0.15p - (15.09%) will pay for maintenance for Procurator House, Village Greens, Play areas, Woodlands, Dog Waste Disposal, H&S Inspections
- 0.22p - (22.09%) will support MUSLA in the development of the Community Centre Site
- 0.45p - (45.10%) will be spent on Servicing & Administering Council Meetings, Answering Public Enquiries, Responding to Consultations, Managing Projects & the Council's Resources, Audit, Insurance & Legal Fees & Litter Picking
