The Community Council is funded by Council Tax. Each January the Community Council identifies local priorities and commitments for the forthcoming year and sets a Budget and Precept. The Precept is then collected by the County Council on behalf of the Community Council. For the financial year, 2015/2016, the Community Council Precept is £149,160

SO WHERE DOES THE MONEY GO? For each £1 spent.....

- 0.01p - (0.61%) will contribute to Civic Events and Projects
- 0.01p - (0.71%) will pay for Hall Hire, Rents and Leases
- 0.02p - (1.59%) will pay for Community Engagement Publications and Events
- 0.03p - (2.68%) will be spent on Audit, Insurance and Legal Fees
- 0.03p - (3.37%) will be spent on Summer Play Schemes and a Youth Support Worker
- 0.04p - (3.69%) will be put aside for Future Expenditure, Cemetery Survey, Elections
- 0.03p - (5.60%) will be spent on administration/stationery costs, training, travelling expenses
- 0.06p - (5.77%) will be spent on Summer Floral Displays, Grasscutting and Xmas Lighting
- 0.06p - (6.03%) will pay for New Play Park Equipment and Car Park Improvements
- 0.07p - (6.70%) will pay for Community Grants
- 0.10p - (10.22%) will pay for Asset Maintenance and Services
- 0.15p - (14.58%) will support the Development of the Community Centre Site
- 0.38p - (38.44%) will be spent on Servicing & Administering Council Meetings, Answering Public Enquiries, Responding to Consultations, Managing Projects & the Council's Resources, & Litter Picking
