## 420 ASSORTED TREE SAPLINGS , STAKES AND GUARDS WERE RECEIVED FROM THE WOODLAND TRUST



Now that the boundary fence has been erected the Wildlife Warriors could start planting the young saplings –

these will form a roadside hedge –

in four or five years time the growth can be layered to form a robust hedge
