- Continuing to try and make the dog fouling initiative as good as it can be. Already got other towns waiting to come on board which is really positive for the possible whole county roll out at the end of the year.
- Continuing to talk to a number of officers trying to ensure certain areas of private land within my constituency are dealt with and cleared up. Proving hard as lots of beauracracy regarding private land.
- Made representation to the planning committee in objection of the windturbines proposed at great house farm.
