**TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2023**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that on 31st May 2023 **MONMOUTHSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL** made an Order under S14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, which came into effect on 31st May 2023. The order has continued in force and would otherwise expire on 30th November 2023 if the direction for an extension had not been given.

The Order has been extended further under the Authority of the Deputy Minister for Climate Change, acting under the authority of the Minister for Climate Change, one of the Welsh Ministers, until and including 30th May 2024 under Section 15 (5) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991).

The effect of the Order was to temporarily close **Footpaths 15(part) and Footpath 16(Part) Undy** as indicated on the order plan. The order and extension to the order has been made due to works on the paths. An alternative route will be available.

By virtue of Section 16(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 a person who contravenes a restriction or prohibition imposed under Section 14 of the Act shall be guilty of an offence.
