On Wednesday 19th July, People Scrutiny rejected the proposals to consult on the five pieces of council owned land and agreed

Option 3: To not recommend any of the pieces of land to cabinet to formally consult upon.

The principal reasons for this recommendation were based on

- 1, multiple concerns about the integrity of the process, perceived inconsistencies, and erroneous information.
- 2, Site specific feedback from residents, communities and their representatives.
- 3, Detailed contributions from local elected members.

It should be noted that the People Scrutiny meeting was billed as a "Pre decision Scrutiny" however, the papers for cabinet - issued on Tuesday 18th July for Cabinet (next week 26th July at 5pm) contain the following agenda item.

Purpose: The purpose of this report is to approve a proposal that the Council consults on the suitability of four pieces of Council owned land for potential development to meet (all or part meet) its statutory obligation to address identified Gypsy and Traveller pitch needs in Monmouthshire. It also recommends further evaluation of a fifth piece of land, to inform possible consultation.

I am advised that the scrutiny feedback will be added to the report pack. I hope that the administration will be taking the scrutiny response as a reflection of the public and member view of the process as flawed and lacking in soundness and integrity.

However, please note that the Cabinet could also choose not to follow the scrutiny recommendation and approve their preferred course of action.
