This Order is made by Monmouthshire County Council ('the authority') under section 257 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 because it is satisfied that it is necessary to divert the footpaths to which this order relate in order to enable development to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted under Part III of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 namely to permit the development of 120 dwellings, associated open space and infrastructure as approved in planning application DM/2021/00357.

BY THIS ORDER:

- 1. The footpaths over the land shown by a bold black line on the attached map and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this order ('the Schedule') shall be diverted as provided below.
- 2. There shall be created to the reasonable satisfaction of the authority an alternative highway for use as a replacement for the said footpath as provided in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by bold black dashes on the attached map.
- 3. The diversion of the footpath shall have effect on the date on which the authority certify that the terms of Article 2 have been complied with.
- 4. The following works shall be carried out in relation to the highway described in Part 2 of the Schedule: To construct a footpath shown by a hatched line on the plan to replace the existing footpath shown by a solid line on the plan.
- 5. The applicant for this Order is hereby required to pay for the cost of carrying out said works.
- 6. Where immediately before the date on which the footpath is diverted there is apparatus under, in, on, over or across it belonging to statutory undertakers for the purpose of carrying on their undertaking, the undertakers shall continue to have the same rights in respect of the apparatus as they then had.
