- Are there plans to remove existing 30mph road signage/markings through the community?
- What was the rationale for implementing a 40mph limit on the B4245 on the approach to Undy from Rogiet? What was the thinking behind the extend of the 40mph limit?
- Are there plans to erect digital signage along the B4245 in Magor and Undy?
- What are the grey boxes along the side of the B4245?

- Are there plans to include Rogiet in the 20mph pilot?
- What are the plans for the pilot? (Timescales, review periods, key success factors etc.)
- Are there plans to ‘even out’ the speed limits on the B4245 through Magor, Undy, Rogiet and Caldicot? Limits jump from 30, 20, 40, 60, 30, 40 to 20 again.
