Steve spoke that he has only 6 volunteers. He spoke about initially they would have a Police letter that would go out however feels that the new letters that go out are don't seem to have the same affect. Asking drivers to slow down for the sake of the environment. This is different to what we understand. The second letter would issue with a fine.

Have repeater signs, and have it painted on the road. Now have signs of 20 MPH in village although this has taken 6 months.

Put up speed indicators

Speed watch indicates 24 mph.

Despite them doing speed checks has not increased Police presence for doing speed checks in Tintern. Sadly people continue to speed through the village.

Steve mentioned about a Wye valley procedure looking at speed and having actual gateways into villages.

There is a Wye Valley project where speed is also going to be part of this. Discussions over having entrances to villages such as a gate, Tintern, Llandogo and St Arvens. Steve will send through the plans that there is around this.

Andrew – it is hoped that MCC will attend the next meeting so that further discussions can be held around what's happening in Tintern.
