NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that **MONMOUTHSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL** of County Hall, The Rhadyr, Usk, NP15 1GA ("the Council") pursuant to the powers conferred by Section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 do **HEREBY ORDER AND DIRECT** that for the purpose of the following regulations shall be observed:

- 1. The Order came into operation on the **21st April 2023** and will continue to be in force for a period not exceeding 18 months or until the works which it is proposed to carry out have been completed, whichever is the earlier. It is anticipated that the works will be completed **on the 21st April 2023**, **operating between 08:00 17:00.**
- 2. The order was necessary **for telecoms maintenance works to take place** in a safe manner at the location. Reasonable access will be maintained for properties fronting the affected lengths of road during the period of the closure.
- 3. The effect of the order was to temporarily close a section of Whitewall, Magor, Monmouthshire.
- 4. A signed diversionary route is in place as follows: Boundary Road, The Causeway, The Ramp, B4245 (Main Road), Newport Road, Redwick Road and vice versa.
- 5. This order may be cited as the Whitewall, Magor, Monmouthshire Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2023
- 6. By virtue of Section 16(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 a person who contravenes a restriction or prohibition imposed under Section 14 of the Act shall be guilty of an offence.
