

Magor Town Council Floral Display Proposal 2026–2027

Contractor Details



Introduction

[REDACTED] is pleased to submit this proposal for the design, installation and maintenance of the Magor Town Council seasonal floral displays for Summer 2026. Our aim is to provide vibrant, high-quality planting displays that enhance the appearance of the community while supporting pollinators and local biodiversity.

Scope of Works

- Clear existing plants, weeds and debris from council planters and containers.
- Dispose of green waste responsibly through recycling.
- Top up planters with high quality compost where required.
- Supply and install seasonal summer bedding plants.
- Water all planters twice per week during the first two weeks after planting.
- Provide optional ongoing weekly watering and maintenance including weeding and deadheading.
- Prepare planters for autumn bulb planting to produce spring 2027 displays.

Summer Planting Scheme

The summer displays will consist of a mixture of colourful bedding plants, trailing plants and structural foliage to provide a full and long-lasting display throughout the summer months. Plants will be selected for visual impact, resilience and pollinator value.

- Petunia
- Geranium (Pelargonium)

- Begonia
- Lobelia
- Calibrachoa
- Verbena
- Cosmos
- Salvia

Where suitable, pollinator-friendly species and small edible plants or herbs may also be incorporated into selected displays.

Local Business Hanging Baskets

The council has indicated that up to 30 local businesses may participate in the scheme. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] can supply and install one or two hanging baskets per participating business. Where hanging baskets are not suitable for a property, a trough or small planter can be provided as an alternative. This will be an additional cost to our initial price.

Method Statement

1. Remove existing planting and prepare containers.
2. Improve growing conditions with fresh compost.
3. Install plants in balanced arrangements of upright, filler and trailing species.
4. Water thoroughly during installation.
5. Provide establishment watering twice per week for the first two weeks.
6. Offer optional weekly maintenance including watering, weeding and deadheading.
7. Work collaboratively with council volunteers maintaining certain planters.
